THOUGHTS FROM OUR MINISTERS

"In Jesus name, Amen". This is a phrase that we hear and learn from an early age on how we are to end our prayers. Well, what does this phrase actually mean?

During the ministry of Jesus on this earth, he talks to his disciples about prayer, and they even ask him on one occasion how to pray. Close to the end of his ministry, he makes the emphasis on how he will no longer be here to pray for them but rather they will need to go to the Father through Him. We read over and over this connection in the epistles of "God the Father through Jesus." These types of phrases connect the 2, means you cannot have one without the other. On other occasions, Paul writes in Romans 8 how the spirit and Jesus both intercede on our behalf during our prayers.

Prayer is a fascinating subject and certainly one that we need to hold close to our hearts, but I would just remind us of WHY we pray in the name of Jesus. This is a sign of authority. This is an acknowledgment of who has the power and control. This is a humble act of knowing that we are not worthy to talk to or be in the presence of God the Father without Jesus the Son. In fact, authority was one of the rewards Jesus received by humbly coming to this earth to be that physical sacrifice we could never be (Philippians 2).

Do you remember, what Jesus told his disciples at the end of the gospels before ascending back to the Father? "All authority has been given to me." We pray in Jesus' name because it is through Him we have to power to overcome this world and we know that He is our Lord.
