## His Life | This Week: The Resurrection and Life



**Scripture Reading**

### Mon

John 14:5-6

In John 14, Jesus is telling His disciples that he must leave them, and the earth, to go and prepare the Heavenly Mansions. Thomas speaks up and asks the question as John 14:5 and 6 tells us... "Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?" Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." In order for us to be with God in Heaven when this life on earth is over we must build a solid relationship with Jesus Christ. Further down, in John 14:21 we find these words which are basic instructions to work on that relationship. "Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him."

**Think about how I can work on my relationship with Jesus to help to secure a home in Heaven**

### Tues

John 14:5-6

Have you ever thought about who Jesus really is? How would you describe who Jesus was? **Jesus was kind** - John 4:1-24 Jesus offered living water and eternal life to the woman at the well. He broke through racial barriers to offer hope to the hurting. **Jesus was perfect** - Hebrews 5:9 He was perfect, with no sin and no faults. **Jesus is our standard** - Phil. 2:1-9 Jesus lived a life of a servant! Jesus left heaven to come to earth to share God's message with the world! **Jesus offers hope** - Luke 19:10 "For the son of man came to seek and save the lost." Jesus went to those who were shunned by the religious men of the day. He gave hope to all, not just those who appeared to be religious. **Jesus is preparing our reunion** - John 14:1-3 Jesus made real the promise of a Heavenly home for those who abide in Him. Think about that final reunion in Heaven where no one is sad, no one is hurting, and it's an eternal celebration.

**Strive to live and make choices just as Jesus would.**

### Wed

2 Corinthians 2:14-17

Have you ever experienced people around you that were able to name where you've been based on what you smell like? If I smell like smoke, I've probably been burning something. If I smell like a particular food item, odds are I probably ate at that type of restaurant. If I smell like coffee, there is a good chance I have been someplace that coffee is sold. Today's passage tells us about what it means to have the fragrance of the knowledge of Jesus. In order for us to enjoy the smell of the knowledge that Jesus provides, we are going to have to spend time with Jesus. Smelling like Jesus means I have been studying God's word and doing the best I can to follow Jesus because he is the way, the truth, and the life.

**Work on spending time with Jesus and listening to God's Word through the Bible.**

### Thurs

John 8:32 & 15:13

What do you look for in a friend? Someone you have known for a while? Maybe a friend is someone who lives close to you. Do you choose your friends based your likes and dislikes? Do you look for some things that you might have in common? A friend is someone you can rely on, or turn to when life gets difficult. Best friends love each other. Some of us are blessed to have a lot of friends in our lives. But, even with a number of people in your life that you call friends maybe two or three people seem to always come to our mind. What friend do you have that will lay down their life to save yours? What friend do you know besides Jesus that not only died for you but also went to prepare an eternal Heaven for you and a way to get there. There is not a friend in our life that can or would do more for us than Jesus.

**Strive to not only appreciate my friendship with Jesus, but also start leading all of my other friends toward a friendship with Him as well.**

### Fri

Matthew 3:16-17

Why do you suppose Jesus went to the river Jordan to be baptized by John? Was He baptized because he was full of sin? No. After all Jesus is God's Son. Did Jesus have a desire to be baptized because all of his friends were getting baptized? No. Jesus was never tempted or influenced to do anything that did not please God. Jesus was baptized because He was following the command of God! The main point and focus of this great event was Jesus simply trying to please His Father! There were three things that Jesus showed us that tell us He is a great example that we must follow. First Jesus showed maturity in following God's wishes during His life on earth. Second, Jesus obeyed commands. If Jesus obeyed God's commands why shouldn't we obey Him also? Jesus also shows us a life of accountability. Because Jesus is our great example, we do all that we can to please our Father.

**Pattern my life after Jesus and follow Paul's advice from 1 Corinthians 11:1. Imitate Jesus!**
