In John 14, Jesus is telling His disciples that he must leave them, and the earth, to go and prepare the Heavenly Mansions. Thomas speaks up and asks the question as John 14:5 and 6 tells us... "Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?" Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." In order for us to be with God in Heaven when this life on earth is over we must build a solid relationship with Jesus Christ. Further down, in John

14:21 we find these words which are basic instructions to work on that relationship.
