Weekly Devotional Thoughts | Richard Perry

So, how do you describe a place as wonderful as Heaven? John used terms like “streets of gold”, “gates of pearl”, “walls of jasper”. Why do you think he used those terms? People often ask me if I think that Heaven is really like that. Well, I don’t... and here’s why:

There’s no way to accurately describe an eternal place using perishable materials. Some of these things last for a very long time, but they are not eternal. The Holy Spirit through Peter in II Peter 3 tells us that all the elements will be burned up. They are not eternal. They are, however, items that we consider to be of great value. That is why Heaven is described the way it is- to be precious to us.

I firmly believe that we could use the most wonderful, amazing, unbelievable terms possible and still couldn’t get close to the splendor and grandeur of Heaven. All we can do is compare it to things that seem valuable to us, when in reality, the only thing that we possess of great value is the soul that God has given us- a soul that He desperately wants to have around His throne in that indescribable place called Heaven.

When people ask me what I think Heaven is really like, I usually respond with something like, “I don’t know for sure, but I know it’s better than what we could ever imagine. Let’s just all go and find out for ourselves”. Sometimes I respond with something like, “If the streets are dirt and the gate is wood and the walls are concrete, would that make you not want to go?”

Folks, listen, here’s the thing- just make sure you go. Just make sure you go. Jesus died so that we can. Let’s not waste the precious gift.
