Weekly Devotional Thoughts | Richard Perry

A few years ago, I decided to get my real estate license. I did my research and enrolled in a local real estate school that I could attend from home via computer. After several weeks of classes, it was time for my test to "graduate" from real estate school. I passed the test with no problem and was ready for the state test from the Board of Realtors, to actually get my license.

Test day came and, honestly, I was a little nervous, having heard horror stories about how hard the test was. I went to the testing station and without exaggerating, I can say that it would probably have been easier to gain admission to a nuclear reactor. After providing proper identification, submitting to a search of my pockets and all my belongings, and filling out a stack of forms, I was allowed to enter the testing center.

An hour and a half passed, and I emerged with a passing grade and a couple of days later, received my official real estate license. I soon learned something they didn't teach in the school- what they taught in the school was how to pass the test, not how to be a realtor. I had no idea what to do next. I had the information, just no clue how to use it.
