Weekly Devotional Thoughts | Terry Coomer

Hebrews 2:1-3 (NKJV):

1. Therefore we must give the more **earnest** heed to the things we have heard, lest we **drift away**. 2. For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, 3. how shall we escape if we **neglect** so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him,

When we read this plea and warning in this second chapter of Hebrews we must remember this is a call to action. Not just in a given point in time, but an ongoing effort. If we fail to keep these teachings in the forefront of our mind, we stand to let salvation slip away.

This thought of “drifting away” gives the image of a boat unknowingly floating away from the shore. Not by any predetermined effort or plan on anyone’s part. When we allow the word of God to become anything other than our number one priority. We begin to slowly make decisions that allows us to look up one day and realize we have grown away from God. We allowed ourselves to “drift away”. It wasn’t a plan it was just “neglect”.

Make sure we never neglect God and let our salvation drift away.
