WHAT IS YOUR SPIRITUAL CONDITION?

### Safe - Not Accountable

Matthew 19:45 (NASB95): But Jesus Said, "Let the children alone, and do not hinder them from coming to Me, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

### Have yet to hear the Gospel

Romans 2:14-16 (NASB95): For when Gentiles who do not have the Law do instinctively the things of the Law, these, not having the Law, are a law to themselves, in that they show the work of the Law written in their hearts, their conscience bearing witness and their thoughts alternately accusing or else defending them, 16 on the day when, according to my gospel, God will judge the secrets of men through Christ Jesus.

### Heard but not obeyed

John 12:48 (NASB95): He who rejects Me and does not receive My sayings, has one who judges him; the word I spoke is what will judge him at the last day.

### Young Christian

Acts 2:42-44 (NASB95): They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 43 Everyone kept feeling a sense of awe; and many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles. 44 And all those who had believed were together and had all things in common;

### Young Christian with weak faith

Matthew 13:20-21 (NASB95): The one on whom seed was sown on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; 21 yet he has no firm root in himself, but is only temporary, and when affliction or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he falls away.

### Mature Christian

Hebrews 5:14 (NASB95): But solid food is for the mature, who because of practice have their senses trained to discern good and evil.

### Unrepentant mature Christian

2 Peter 2:20-21 (NASB95): For if, after they have escaped the defilements of the world by the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and are overcome, the last state has become worse for them than the first. 21 For it would be better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn away from the holy commandment handed on to them.
