Weekly Devotional Thoughts | Terry Coomer

WHAT DOES A CHRISTIAN LOOK LIKE?

This is week 7 in our series. Over the past few week we looked at LOVE, OBEDIENCE, PRAYER, A SERVENT HEART, FORGIVING and WORKER as a few CHARACTERISTICS that a Christian should exhibit. This week let's look at:

COMPASSION LIKE CHRIST

A Christian must follow Jesus's example of compassion. In Matthew 9:35-38 (NKJV): 35 Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. 36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. 37 Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. 38 Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

It is through the eyes of compassion that we see others in need of the same thing we need, Grace. With compassion, we like Christ can see the physical and spiritual needs of others. Like Christ we are motivated to try and meet those needs. Throughout Jesus's ministry we see Jesus meet the physical needs, whether it was feeding the hungry as we see In Matthew 14:13-21, healing the sick in Matthew 9:35-38, and even raising the dead in John 11:38-44.

Apart from all of these examples of Jesus meeting these physical needs, the very fact that Jesus came to earth in the form of a man was to meet our spiritual needs. His sacrifice on the Cross is where we find hope of salvation.
