WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT:

WORSHIP (part 1)

From Adam and Eve until today God has always told man how he wants to be worshiped. We have always had a pattern to follow. Through the study of scripture we can see that God did not leave this up to individuals to figure out. We can see that there are acceptable and unacceptable ways to worship God.

God is our creator and has every right to demand and expect our worship. He even has the right to demand how we worship. Throughout the ages man has tried to customize his worship to what feels right or what is convenient. That has never worked out very well.

Remember that the judgment of one individual or nation is a warning to others. With that in mind let's look at some examples of how false worship worked out in the past.

Look at Gen 4:2-5 (NKJV) 2 Later she gave birth to his brother Abel. Now Abel kept flocks, and Cain worked the soil. 3 In the course of time Cain brought some of the fruits of the soil as an offering to the Lord. 4 And Abel also brought an offering-fat portions from some of the firstborn of his flock. The Lord looked with favor on Abel and his offering, 5 but on Cain and his offering he did not look with favor. So Cain was very angry, and his face was downcast.---We see here that we can worship in such a way that our worship will not be accepted. Let's look at Leviticus10:1,2 (NKJV) 1Then Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, each took his censer and put fire in it, put incense on it, and offered profane fire before the Lord, which He had not commanded them. 2 So fire went out from the Lord and devoured them, and they died before the Lord. --- we see here how important it is worship God the way we are told to.--- Ask your self this, Does God recognize your worship or is it like strange fire to Him???

Next week we will look at 2Kings 12: 26-33. Ask yourself these questions.

Does God have a pattern of worship for us to follow? Are we at liberty to change that pattern? Are there consequences if we do?
