WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT:

TEMPTATION *part 1*

The Bible tells us that temptation alone is not sin. We read in **Hebrews 4:15 ESV** - 15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, **yet without sin**. --Our Lord and Savior in order to be that perfect sacrifice for our sin had to be with out sin. He also was our perfect example.

His example on how to combat temptation can be found in Luke 4:2-13. The account described by Luke describes that Jesus had been fasting and was hungry. It is in this state that the devil tries to tempt him. There are three different attempts by the devil, and three responses by Jesus.

Just like the devil tempted Eve in the Garden with lies and deceit, we see the same tactics here with Jesus. I think it is important to note that Jesus was 100% man and 100% God. He was physically and mentally weak and hungry just like we would be. If Jesus was not truly hungry he could not truly be tempted to fall for the devils attempts.

We read in James 1:13-15 ESV - 13 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God," for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one. **14 But each person is tempted when he is lured and enticed by his own desire. 15 Then desire when it has conceived gives birth to sin, and sin when it is fully grown brings forth death.**

Unlike Eve in the Garden, when she aloud herself to be enticed by the devils lies and reacted in a way that it became sin. Jesus responded with scripture every time. We can follow that example, the key is to study and know God's will so we will know how to recognize and respond when the devil tempts us.

It is comforting to know that God has limited the devils power. James 4:6-7 ESV - " 7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. **Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.** --With God's help we can overcome anything the devil throws at us.
