Weekly Devotional Thoughts | Terry Coomer

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT:

TEMPTATION part 2

As we discussed last week, part 1 on TEMPTATION, we learned the devil is limited in his power. The description of the devil in Peter 5:8 ESV - 8 Be sober-minded; be watchful. **Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.** --Peter paints a picture here that we can all relate to. Lions will often watch and wait from a distance and single out an injured or weak animal in a pack. When we are weak physically, mentally, or spiritually, that is when the devil will try to tempt us. <u>Be</u> <u>sober-minded; be watchful.</u> A passage from Job really brings this picture home Job 1:7 NASB95 - 7 The LORD said to Satan, "From where do you come?" **Then Satan answered the LORD and said, "From roaming about on the earth and walking around on it."** The devil is cunning, crafty, and deceitful. We must be ready to defend against his attacks. A lion has sharp claws, sharp teeth, powerful paws, and incredible speed. These are his weapons, by the grace of God we have defensive and offensive weapons and can stand ready.

Read Ephesians 6:10-11 NASB95 - 10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. 11 **Put on the full armor of God,** so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. --God did not leave us here to defend for ourselves. The better we know God and His word the better we can defend ourselves. On the other hand, the better we understand our enemy we can defend against him.

Note here in the book of John one of the devil's attributes: John 8:44 ESV - You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies. The devil will lie and try to entice us to do his will, we need to be ready and watchful.

God also gives us a look inside the devil's arsenal, read the following passages: I John 2:15-17 ESV - 15 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world—<u>the desires of the</u><u>flesh</u> and the <u>desires of the eyes</u> and <u>pride of life</u>—is not from the Father but is from the world. 17 And the world is passing away along with its desires, <u>but whoever does the will of God abides forever</u>. These three pitfalls are the very tools the devil used to tempt Eve and Jesus.

Another tool we have is our church family, when you feel weak and discouraged, you are not alone. Let your brothers and sisters stand with you. That is what family is for. Ecclesiastes 4:12 ESV – 12 And though a man might prevail against one who is alone, two will withstand him—a threefold cord is not quickly broken.
