What does the Bible say about: BEING CONFIDENT IN OUR SALVATION (part 1)

Doubt is a dangerous thing. It is probably one of the most used tools in the devil's tool bag. Ask yourself, does God want us to wander around wondering if we are saved? Let's look at scripture to find the answer.

Jesus said in **Luke 19:10 (ASV)** For the Son of man came to seek and to save that which was lost. We read in **John 10:10 (ASV)** The thief cometh not, but that he may steal, and kill, and destroy: I came that they may have life, and may have it abundantly. — Do you think this abundant life that Jesus came to give us is, "**I hope I am saved**" or "**I know I am Saved**"? Do you think that Jesus came to seek the lost so that we could know we were in a safe condition or to only question it daily?

The Apostle John repeatedly tries to reassure us in 1 John that we can know our spiritual condition. Look at 1 John 5:13 (ASV) These things have I written unto you, that ye may know that ye have eternal life, even unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God. This passage gives little doubt that we can know. The question is how. John says he has written these things so we can be confident in our eternal salvation, what things did he write?

John points out at least 5 areas that we can look at and compare our lives with, so we can know where we stand spiritually.

- 1) Are we obeying Him?
 - a) 1 John 2:3 (ASV) And hereby we know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. 1 John 2:4 (ASV) He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him; 1 John 2:5 (ASV) but whoso keepeth his word, in him verily hath the love of God been perfected. Hereby we know that we are in him:

The first question to ask ourselves, are we obeying his commandments? **Heb 5:9 (ASV)** and having been made perfect, **he became unto all them that obey him the author of eternal salvation**;

Next week we will pick up with Question 2-5. I will leave you with this thought: **John 14:15 (ASV) If ye love me, ye will keep my commandments**.
