What does the Bible say about:
BEING CONFIDENT IN OUR SALVATION (part 3)

Over the last few weeks we have looked at several statements that John gives us in 1 John that we can compare our lives with, so that we can know and be assured of our salvation. The first Question we needed to ask ourselves was, **"Are we obeying Him" 1 John 2:3?** the second question **"Are we imitating Christ" 1 John 2:6?**

This week we will look at the third area that John says we can compare our lives with and stand confident in our Salvation.

Question #3. **Do you love your Brother?**

1 John 3:11 (AVS) For this is the message which ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another:

John again reassures us in the following passages that if we love one another then we can know that He (Christ) abideth in us, if we keep His commandments and **love one another**.

1 John 3:23 (ASV) And this is his commandment, that we should believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ, **and love one another**, even as he gave us commandment. **1 John 3:24 (ASV)** And he that keepeth his commandments abideth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he gave us.---

1 John 3:14 (ASV) We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not abideth in death.

If we are **obedient to God's instructions, imitators of Christ**, and **love our brothers** we can stand confident in our spiritual condition.

John 13:34 (ASV) A new commandment I give unto you, that ye love one another; even as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.

John 13:35 (ASV) By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.
