ries. Even if we don't have the health we would like, we have access to  
the finest medical facilities in the world to help us when we are sick. We  
have a Bible that is capable of directing our lives to God and His perfect  
Will. Considering all this, we should really take the advice of the classic  
hymn written by Johnson Oatman and E.O. Excell, "Count Your Bless-  
ings."

*"When upon life's billows you are tempest tossed, When you are dis-  
couraged, thinking all is lost, Count your many blessings, name them  
one by one, And it will surprise you what the Lord hath done."*

We don't need to ask God to bless us! When we take time to count our  
many blessings, we will see that God has already blessed us! We don't  
need to beg God for His blessings. We need to thank God because He  
has already blessed us! As Paul wrote, *"Do not be anxious about any-
